

talking in sentences:

Hold real conversations with your child.

*Get her to describe things to you,
tell you what she has been doing in sentences.*

Ask questions about each thing your child says
so that the conversation continues.

Allow your child to use the **telephone** to talk
to grandparents, etc.

*This is a wonderful way to get children to use sentences and learn to
converse.*



Many children come to a school having never heard a sentence in conversation with them.

"Sit down." "Don't touch." "Tea time".

This clipped language does not assist with the development of the
language which will assist with reading and writing.

learning specific language:

*** language about self**

Talk about your **child's body parts**, particularly those
parts which will be referred to and used at school like
feet, hands, fingers, ears, wrist, elbow, thumb.



Talk about things **related to your child**

*clothes,
house,
family,
street name and number,
birthdate, age,
family pet,
friends,
shadow, etc.*
